

Important topics for a beginning small business were covered during the counseling process, such as license information, insurance, LLC information, and what consider when negotiating a lease. After speaking with Connie Whitt and Mitch McDowell at the GC SBDC, Crystal was able to negotiate a lease with a month and half free rent while she prepared her hair salon.
