

Nearly two weeks ago, the MSBDC was deeply saddened by the loss of Dr. Frank Wiebe, a stalwart and valuable member of the MSBDC team. We can only express our most sincere condolences for his family as we keep them in our prayers.

Dr. Frank Adams Wiebe, 71, of Tupelo, Miss., died Tuesday, November 1, 2011, at The North Mississippi Medical Center. He was born on July 26, 1940, in Lawrence, Kansas. He received three degrees from the University of Kansas: B.S. in Business Administration, June 1962; M.A. in Social Psychology, May 1971; and Ph.D. in Business, May 1975. He was a member of the United States Air Force serving on Active Duty, November 1963 -May 1968, and the Active Reserve, September 1969 - July 1974, with Captain the highest rank held.
